We will soon share information of how we can communicate both these things to you through the Seesaw app!


Tempest Photographs

For those of you who ordered school photos last session - Tempest Photography reopen on September. We hopefully will receive the photographs shortly after this date.


Safe Drop off and Pick ups

The safety of our children remains our top priority. Please be mindful of parking during drop and off and pick up. Stopping or parking on the zig zags is illegal 8am-6pm Monday to Friday. Parking on pavements can also be very
